



The 2016 PRO-AM Championship is a "re-birth" of the Falcon Pro Championship with a great new format, simple rules and Fun, Low Cost Racing for ALL!

As previously, the championship will run over 6 venues / events;-

Richardsons, Luton, Raceway 81, Oaklands, North London and Pinewood, giving a great range of venues from smaller club tracks to larger 6 lane and raceway tracks.

## **Rules & Racing Classes**

## Classes;-

1) 1/32 Pro-Am Sports ;- a choice of production chassis or laser cut chassis (maximum bare chassis kit retail price of £30.00)

Motors ;- FK type, sealed motors only (typically Falcon 7, JK Hawk 7, Hawk Retro etc. (maximum retail price £12.00)

Maximum width; - 64mm. Maximum Wing height; - 32.5mm.

Body;- any commercially available 1/32 scale Sports or Sports GT body.

Race format;- One minute qualifying into segment finals. Win from any Final.

2) 1/32 Pro- Am Formula One: - Free choice of chassis (maximum retail bare kit price of £34.00).

Motors; - FK type, sealed motors only (typically Falcon 7, JK Hawk 7, Hawk Retro etc. (maximum retail price £12.00)

Maximum width ;- 68mm. Front tyres, minimum diameter 14mm, minimum front tyre width 4mm.

Body; Any commercially available 1/32 scale Formula One Body. Maximum Wing height 30mm.

Race format;- One minute qualifying into segment finals. Win from any Final.

## 3) 1/24th Scale PRO-AM Team Race ;-

Teams may be 2 Pro Drivers (Pro Championship)

Or

(Pro-AM Teams) have at least one novice driver (of BSCRA "Clubman status" or as deemed by the officials should it be the case of an experienced, unclassified racer).

Race Format: - 1 hour Team race with equal driving time for each driver.

The Cars;- 1/24 production Chassis or any GT12 type laser chassis (maximum retail price for the bare chassis kit of £29.00)

Motors; - FK type, sealed motors only (typically Falcon 7, JK Hawk 7, Hawk Retro etc. (maximum retail price £12.00)

Maximum width ;- 83mm Maximum wing Height 38mm

Body; - Any commercially available 1/24th scale Sports, Sports GT or Saloon car body. (No wing car bodies!)

**Concours Award ;-** Judged over all 3 classes for one winner. The winner will be awarded 2 points to the specific championship (e.g. - win concours in F1 and get + 2 points in the F1 championship)
